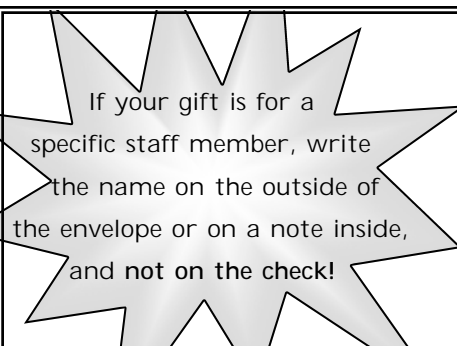


How'd it go? We had a work weekend on Feb 12-13. It was awesome! Over 70 adults and teenagers came to help out. We had work teams in each room of the new dorm basement, hanging insulation and then sheet rock. We got every room, except the bathrooms, insulated and sheet rocked by mid-afternoon. Another team drilled the holes and set rebar in the top of the burned out basement walls. This will allow more head room downstairs when we start building on the old dorm. We also had a team bucket ashes out of the basement. When this is finished, we will clean the walls and the floor, then apply sealer to prevent the cracks, caused by the extreme heat, from leaking. For 2 weekends before the work day, there was a group of men that came to help Cliff build the frames for bunk beds. Then during the work day, a few young men helped Cliff assemble them in one of the new dorm rooms. This will give us 30+ more beds when complete. We also had a great time of fellowship and encouragement. Thank you to all who came and those who prayed. -Andrew
